



VINTAGE 2013

Grapes grown from some of the most choice land in the surrounding region of La Motte en Provence, consisting primarily of Grenache, Rolle (Vermentino), Cinsault, Syrah and Tibouren. Harvesting at sunrise to noon. Optical grape sorting. Destemming and slight crushing at 7-8°C to avoid oxidation. Both the free run and pressed juices are vinified in stainless steel. «Bâtonnage» is twice weekly. Temperature controlled.
